## **24/74 Approval of minutes of the meeting held on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2024**

## **24/75 County Councillors Report**

Explained his interaction from SAG regarding Sherwood Pines Concert.

Bus Stops installed at the junction of Mill Lane and B6030 near Sherwood Pines prior to the Concert.

Gorethorpe Lane conversations regarding Via improvements are ongoing.

Scoping exercise to see if it is possible to provide a footpath from bus the stops at Mill Lane into the village is ongoing the next to find a suitable fund.

## **24/76 District Councillors Report**

Planning app for 124 dwellings on form collier site Cllr peacock is listening to residents' concerns, there has been a delay in the application which will possible be made in September.

A leveling up fund of £20million was awarded, two communications confirming the proposal has been adopted, and it is moved to memoranda, but delayed due to election.

NSDC cabinet agreed to back the work at

Ollerton, which would provide retail, residential, public house and a walkway/road.

Clipstone work would include sports center hub, at the colliery holding site, high energy workspace/jobs would be provided, regeneration work at Vicker Water, with an educational center including biodiversity.

Politicians need to look at the impact on Kings Clipstone going forward on future developments.

Cllr Stevenson: raised the point of tourism and footpaths and if any of the leveling up fund would be used.

County Cllr Peacock: a strategy was being developed for footpaths and active travel.

Cllr Stanley: raised the point about a footpath through the village, Cllr Stanley will provide a plan to CC Peacock.

Cllr Bromley: asked about section 106 payments from developers, some of the money should be spent on footpaths to and from Kings Clipstone.

The Safer Advisory Group (SAG) had a further meeting, regarding Sherwood Forest Concert, the parish council concerns were presented.

#### **24/77 Questions / Statements from members of the public**

A member of the public raised rubbish after the concert.

A person was sleeping in the Telephone Box.

The bridleway near the fishing ponds will be repaired and completed in 3-4 days by local landowners.

A discussion took place regarding the land on the B6030 at the top of the rat hole, local company to provide two further soldiers, would require a donation from KCPC, resident to ask the question regarding amount of donation.
