25/129	County Councillors Report <u>NOTED:</u> Cllr James Gamble sent a report to update council on the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Correspondence sent to Highways regarding the proposed 40 mph speed limit consultation on B6030 Clipstone Road and B6034 Edwinstowe and Rufford Roads, with a request to extend the 40 mph zone to Holly Farm Business Centre and consider a 50 mph limit on remaining sections. • Requests submitted to Via East Midlands for clearance and siding up of pavements along Mansfield Road into Squires Lane and Clipstone Road up to Holly Farm Business Centre. • Discussion held with landowner regarding fence damage following a recent road traffic accident in Kings Clipstone. • Gulleys and grips along Clipstone Road have been cleared, this should improve drainage and road safety. • Request made to Via East Midlands for speed enforcement measures on the main road into Kings Clipstone, to be considered by the Nottinghamshire Safer Roads Partnership and Nottinghamshire Police.

	<p>NOTED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One member of the public asked if a piece of agricultural land is in the neighbourhood plan, a copy of the neighbourhood plan was given to the member of the public for them to review. • A member of the public reported a bad smell coming from the grate on Squires Lane . • A member of the public wanted to thank Cllr Sipson and her daughter for the food provided at the recent Halloween event, £151.20 was made and any profits after expenses have been taken out are going to be donated to the shed funds. • A member of the public wanted to thank the volunteers who decorated the village for Remembrance day. • It was raised that water is collecting at the junction of Gorsethorpe Lane and Squires Lane.
