Works are planned to address flooding, and it has been identified that one of the soakaways is currently blocked. • The Virgin utility boxes that were obstructing visibility on Cavendish have now been relocated. • A request is being progressed to reduce the speed limit to 50mph on Clipstone Road near Rufford and Centre Parcs. • A traffic survey is due to be carried out on Mansfield Road. • The issue regarding the fence near the Dog and Duck is currently with legal services at the county council and may take some time to resolve.
